The World Health Organization presents its compliments and has the honour to communicate, in accordance with Articles 3(a) and 7 of the “Procedure for the Selection of Recommended International Nonproprietary Names for Pharmaceutical Substances” adopted by the Executive Board in its resolution EB15.R7,¹ a list of names which has been published as International Nonproprietary Names recommended by the World Health Organization (abbreviation Rec. INN)² on the WHO website at <https://www.who.int/teams/health-product-and-policy-standards/inn/inn-lists>.

In accordance with Article 8 of the above-mentioned Procedure, the World Health Organization requests that the above-mentioned list of names be recognized as the nonproprietary names for the substances in question, and that the necessary steps be taken to prevent the acquisition of proprietary rights in the names, including prohibition of registration of the names as trademarks or tradenames.
