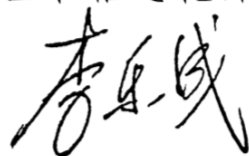

China highly values the important role of the ITU in bridging the digital divide, fostering innovations in ICTs and facilitating more equitable, rational, efficient, and economical use of radio spectrum and satellite orbit resources. We are committed to making further contributions to the common development of global ICTs.

Noting the absence of official bids from ITU Member States to host the World Radiocommunication Conference 2027 (WRC-27), China formally extended an invitation to the 2024 Session of ITU Council to host the WRC-27 and its related events. The capability of Shanghai to host WRC-27 has been proven by ITU's on-site assessment carried out in February, 2025.
