Estonia is pleased to submit a nomination "Mumming and masking in Estonia during St. Martin's Day and St. Catherine's Day" to the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. - The signed grants of rights covering all submitted photos and videos. The paper documents with original signatures will be delivered to UNESCO secretariat during the Executive Board's Spring Session, 2-17 April 2025.
