Venue	Course will be organised in Pohjois-Suomen Maijanlampi training area. Address: Ouluntie 58, 93400 Taivalkoski Venue is located approximately 5 km before Taivalkoski on the right side of highway 20. Travel distance from Helsinki is approximately 800 km and the travel will take approximately 11 hours (with one stoppage). Travel by vehicle with petrol engine is recommended as the temperatures might go as low as - 40 C. Nearest airport: Kuusamo. 70 km from Kuusamo to Taivalkoski. Road 20 to Oulu. Students will be sent to the training area on the first day of the course. Departure from the hotel at 9:45.
Accommodation	Accommodation has been reserved for 10.-16.2.2019 in Hotel Herkko. Accommodation in Hotel Herkko is include in the price of the course. Hotel address and contact information: Taivalvaarantie 2, Taivalkoski. +358 (0) 8 717 1700. http://www.hotelliherkko.com/ The reception at the hotel closes at 20:00. If you choose not to accommodate in the hotel that has been reserved for you by the organizer, please inform the course manager as soon as possible.
Meals	Breakfast, lunch and dinner are include in the price of the course. Meals are served at Hotel Herkko. Breakfast is served 7:00 - 10:00 on weekdays and 8:00 - 11:00 on weekends.
Equipment	You are welcome to bring your own riding gear to the course. Riding gear are available at the course venue, but we understand that using own gear can make the practice more enjoyable. The weather conditions can change a lot during the day and we recommend that you bring with you enough extra clothing and warm clothing with you. You are also welcome to bring small snacks with you for breaks during the training. We aim to organize most of the breaks in a classroom from located at the training venue. It is possible to change clothing in the classroom and the building also has sanitary facilities. If you wish to shower in this venue you should bring your own towel with you. We recommend that bring personal equipment that you might need during the field training (compass, knife, fire making equipment, flashlight, small backpack, etc.). Neck wind protector is recommended due to weather conditions. Snowmobiles for training are provided by the organizer. Organiser will provide GPS-devices and communication equipment. You can bring your personal GPS device if the electronic map covers the region of Taivalkoski.
