



## **STATE SAFETY PROGRAMME**

### **Course Goal**

The course will provide the managers and personnel within State Aviation agencies with the competencies required to develop and implement State Safety Programmes in their States as per ICAO Annexes and applicable State's rules.

### **Learning Objectives**

After successful completion of the course, participants will be able to:

1. provide recommendations for the SSP legal and institutional framework;
2. develop the Plan for SSP implementation;
3. develop a Strategy for Safety Promotion;
4. use supporting tools and processes needed to enable safety data analysis;
5. apply processes with appropriate tools to State safety risk management; and
6. establish mechanism for State safety performance management.

Managers and personnel within State Aviation agencies responsible for State Safety Programme

### **Secondary Target Population**

Personnel from the main technical divisions/sections/departments related to direct implementation and operation of the State Safety Programme (SSP)

### **Entry Requirements**

- Computer literacy using contemporary software programs
- College degree or equivalent qualifications and experience in civil aviation
- Management experience in State's CAAs
