October 8-9 2025 | Copenhagen, Denmark

Join us for *Life Science: A Catalyst for European Competitiveness*, a part of *Copenhagen Life Science Summit*, an official conference during Denmark's Presidency of the Council of the European Union in the second half of 2025. The conference is hosted by Healthcare Denmark, taking place in Copenhagen on October 8-9 2025.

The high-level conference will bring together decision-makers, public health organisations, industry, patient organisations, and academia from across EU27+, creating an international forum for the European life Science ecosystem to meet, exchange insights, and engage in discussions on the European Strategy for Life Sciences.

The conference will explore the state of the current EU health and life science ecosystem, highlighting the need for a strong, integrated European ecosystem, with discussions on how to unlock Europe's potential by making sure that strategic investment in health and stronger public-private partnerships can enhance economic productivity, reduce healthcare costs, and build social resilience and equity.

Together, we will explore how Europe can advance its position as a leading life science region – ensuring our competitiveness and contributing to more resilient, innovative health systems that benefit patients across Europe.

The two-day programme includes:

- On October 8, a standing dinner reception at Copenhagen City Hall.
- On October 9, the conference: *Life Science: A Catalyst for European Competitiveness* at Maersk Tower, Copenhagen University.
