The visit will include meetings, site visits, and seminar organised in cooperation with the Estonian Academy of Security Sciences.

The seminar will focus on the detention and management of prisoners of war (POWs) and will be held at the Estonian Academy of Security Sciences in Tallinn on August 13. Over 100 participants are expected, including representatives from the Estonian Prison Service, Defence Forces, Ministry of Justice, Ministry of Defence, and other state agencies.

The seminar may include different formats such as presentations, panel interventions or Q&A-led discussions. The preferred working language is English. Due to the sensitive nature of the topics, the use of video conferencing solutions (e.g. Teams) is discouraged.

All related costs will be covered by the Estonian side.
