2	Spring seminar "Kahn and The Nordic Sensibility"	15.04.2022	09.05.2022
<div>Tegevuse täpsustus: The spring seminar is an introduction to the 3-year programme. It is an academic and popular-scientific event for architects, public policy makers and students. It is the hybrid-event, which makes the Norwegian-Estonian initiative available to the wider audience – from the Baltic Sea to the Mediterranean and beyond.</div>			
3	"The Nordic Latitudes": translation, design, printing (312 pgs); a research (both theoretical and on-site visits) about Kahn and Korsmo in 2024.	15.04.2022	31.12.2022
<div>Tegevuse täpsustus: Per Olaf Fjeld's and Emily Fjeld's monograph is the most comprehensive approach of the development of architectural thought that characterizes Norway and Estonia in the revolutionary 20th century. The work sensitively intertwines both the local and the universal level – highlighting the specific features of the countries as well as their common features. It turns out that both countries have a direct connection to the ideas matured in Pennsylvania and Louis Kahn's Masterclasses. In Norway as a very direct impact from the 1930s, in Estonia a little more indirectly and from the 1960s. Fjeld's work is also characterized by a nuanced and thoughtful text that is both clear and bright; the wording is both subtle and smooth. A separate value lies in the monograph index and the list of sources, which form a strong basis for academic cooperation. From the activity's budget we'll cover the marketing related to the publication and distribution of "The Nordic Latitudes".</div>			
4	Christian Norberg-Schulz's writings: translation	15.04.2022	31.12.2022
<div>Tegevuse täpsustus: Christian Norberg-Schulz's small, even non-existent representation in our libraries speaks in his favor. Yet Christian Norberg-Schulz was one of the few individuals who could shape Western architectural theory during the so-called post-modern period of the 1970s. It was his books, not so much the designs, that brought him international recognition. Now, our readers and researchers in Estonia will gradually have the opportunity to learn about these works. It is also important to realize that Norberg-Schultz sometimes represents a counterinterview to these ideas and views that characterize the so-called Kahn's discourse. They are perfect supplements to each other, knowing that the evolutionary share of Norberg-Schultz and Kahn later increased. Norberg-Schultz has had a direct influence on Estonian architectural thinking.</div>
