- 12:00 14:00: Working lunch on preventing and combatting men's violence against women and domestic violence
- 14:00 16:00: Roundtable discussion on preventing and combatting honour-based violence and oppression

We will meet at the Government Office's Dining Halls, in Rosenbad, Drottninggatan 3, for a working lunch to exchange experiences on policy to prevent and combat men's violence against women and domestic violence.

Following the lunch, we will meet for a roundtable discussion on preventing and combatting honour-based violence and oppression. This high-level meeting will take place in the Government Office's meeting venue Lunden, Drottninggatan 4. The roundtable will commence with presentations by

NIKK, the Nordic co-operation body for Information on Gender, and by the Swedish Gender Equality Agency. These presentations will provide a Nordic and international perspective on current work to prevent and combat honour-based violence and oppression.
