The meeting is organised within the framework of the project Improvement and cooperation with third countries in the field of return.

The planned agenda for the meeting is as follows:

1. Detention of persons and processes of expulsion at the Detention Centre

3. Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration Programme in Estonia –International Organization for Migration (IOM)
4. Possibilities to help victims of human trafficking within national victim support service
5. Resolution of a labour dispute in the labour dispute committee
