Dear Director Murd,

As the 79th World Health Assembly (WHA) is scheduled to take place from May 18-23 in Geneva, on behalf of the Government of the Republic of China (Taiwan), I am writing to inform you that a delegation led by our Ministry of Health and Welfare will be in Geneva during the Assembly. The delegation aims to launch Taiwan's annual campaign to join the WHA as an observer, as well as to meet with officials and medical experts from diplomatic allies and like-minded countries.

At the outset, I would like to express our deepest gratitude to the Government of the Republic of Estonia for its steadfast support. For consecutive years, Estonia has bravely spoken out on the international stage in support of Taiwan's meaningful participation in the WHO. Your country's consistent principled stand and willingness to advocate for global health inclusivity have deeply moved the people of Taiwan.

Therefore, I would like to take this opportunity to solicit your understanding and kind assistance in making the following requests possible:

1. Kindly instruct your delegation/mission based in Geneva to meet with Taiwan's health officials for a bilateral talk and to attend professional fora and a welcome reception. If this is agreeable to you, the name and the title of the designated official for the talk, as well as the medical issues your delegation would like to include, will be needed.
