WITH REFERENCE to Focused Circular No 69(25), dated 4 December 2025, by which the Member States of the HCCH were invited to cast their votes before 4 June 2026, in accordance with Article 2 of the HCCH's Statute, on the proposal made by the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands for the admission of the **Republic of Indonesia** as a Member of the HCCH;

HAVING NOTED the votes cast by Member States within the deadline mentioned above, and

WHEREAS no Member State has cast a vote against the admission within the period of time provided;


