Estonian Defence Forces Championship in Floorball

1. **Purpose:** To develop team sport in Estonian Defence Forces and to find out the best athletes in floorball.
2. **Time and Place:** 11th of March 2026. University of Life Sciences Sports Hall (Friedrich Reinhold Kreutzwaldi 3, 51014 Tartu).
3. **Registration:** Request to participate please inform Estonian unit POC or Estonian unit sport instructor before 03rd of March 2026.
4. **Participants:** Estonian Defence Forces, Estonian Defence League and allied troops units. Team consists max 12 players + 1 coach.
5. **Time Schedule**

9:00	Registration and warm-up
10:00	Tournament 1 st games
12:00-14:00	Lunch
16:00	Final match
16:40	Award ceremony
6. **Regulations and rules:**
 - 6.1. Competition will be held in round-robin system, after group stage play-off games.
 - 6.2. Teams have 4 field players on the field at the same time, the game is played without a goalkeeper.
 - 6.3. 28m x 15m indoor hockey field, which is surrounded by ports on the sides and ends. The size of the gate is 60 x 90 cm. There is a 50 x 120 cm area in front of the goal where the field player may not stand.
 - 6.4. Substitute players are located behind the port, substitution takes place from the marked area.
 - 6.5. Playing time 2 x 10 minutes of running time, the last minute is pure time, the break between halves is 2 minutes.
 - 6.6. Team can take one 30 sec time-out during the game.
 - 6.7. In the group-stage, the games may end in a draw, in the elimination games, penalty kicks are thrown after a draw in normal time (3 players, from the center line into an empty goal).
 - 6.8. For additional information, please contact with Estonian unit POC or Estonian unit sport instructor.
 - 6.9. Wearing goggles in the game is recommended.
7. **Prize Distribution:**
 - 7.1. Teams who recorded the 1st, the 2nd and the 3rd place will be awarded by trophy and medals.
 - 7.2. Winner team in Estonian Defence Forces category (EDF units) will be awarded with t-shirt of Defence Forces Master.
 - 7.3. Best scores and best player will be awarded with Defence Academy souvenirs.
8. **Other matters.**
 - 8.1. Lunch (soup, pie, berry juice/tea) is provided by the organizer of the competition.
