The ongoing changes in the European security environment, in particular in the context of Russia's unprovoked and unjustified aggression against Ukraine, indicate the need of further strengthening the military cooperation of NATO Member States in order to increase the level of security of the Alliance.

In this context and with reference to our conversation during my visit to Estonia in February 2024, I would like to inform you that the Polish Armed Forces remain ready to participate in joint fire training using K9 platforms. Such training could take place in the second half of June 2024 in Estonia.

It will be a great opportunity to enhance training skills of our crews and staff personnel and will to strengthen our readiness.
