Excellency,

The Office of the Pyithu Hluttaw has the honour to inform Your Excellency that the General Election for the Multi-Party Democratic System was successfully held throughout the Republic of the Union of Myanmar under the supervision of the Union Election Commission on three separate dates: 28 December 2025, 11 January 2026, and 25 January 2026. The election was contested by sixty-three (63) political parties, including parties representing the various ethnic nationalities of Myanmar.

Following the successful completion of the General Election, the First Regular Session of the Third Pyithu Hluttaw (House of Representatives) commenced on 16 March 2026 with the participation of 373 Members of Parliament. The First Regular Session of the Third Amyotha Hluttaw (House of Nationalities) commenced on 18 March 2026 with the participation of 213 Members of Parliament. Subsequently, the First Regular Session of the Third Pyidaungsu Hluttaw (Union Parliament), comprising the Pyithu Hluttaw and the Amyotha Hluttaw, commenced on 20 March 2026 at the Hluttaw Complex in Nay Pyi Taw.

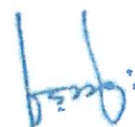
The Hluttaw sessions are currently being conducted in accordance with the Constitution of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, as well as the relevant laws, rules, and procedures of the respective Hluttaws. Members of Parliament are actively carrying out parliamentary activities, including the establishment of committees, legislative processes, and discussions on matters aimed at promoting the interests and well-being of the people through democratic practices.

To ensure the effective implementation of parliamentary functions and to strengthen cooperation with international parliaments, various parliamentary committees have been established, including Standing Committees, ad hoc Committees, the Joint Committee on the ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly (JCAIPA), and the Joint Committee on the Inter-Parliamentary Union (JCIPU). The Pyithu Hluttaw Office expresses its sincere desire to further strengthen cooperation and exchanges with Your Excellency's esteemed Parliament and looks forward to working together to promote mutual understanding and parliamentary relations.
