Early movers often pave the way, while hesitation can lead to regret, delaying rather than accelerating transitions.

I am pleased to personally invite you to "Collaborating Amidst Disruptions", a World Energy Council Executive Briefing for Senior Policymakers and Senior Government Officials, where I will explore how different approaches and choices for cooperation and collaboration can impact the pace and scale of emergent innovation and unlock energy transitions. Drawing on the latest World Energy Scenario Foundations, we will delve into how these choices shape the future of energy systems.
