AS RSTA application regarding authorisation by the Latvian administration as Accounting Authority and Inmarsat Point (AAIC) of Service Activation

Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Latvia has received an application of the AS RSTA requesting the authorisation by the Latvian administration as the Accounting Authority and the Inmarsat Point of Service Activation.

According to the Article A.3.2.2 of the ITU (International Telecommunication Union) Recommendation D.90 "Charging, Billing, International Accounting and Settlement in the Maritime Mobile Service" the Administration may recognize an accounting authority based in another country to have responsibility for maritime mobile stations which it has licensed. In such cases, the recognizing Administration shall notify this fact to the Administration of the country in which the accounting authority is based and ask for confirmation of its AAIC. In addition, the Article A.3.3.1 requires an accounting authority to notify its AAIC to the Administration of each country recognizing it as an accounting authority for maritime mobile stations which it has licensed.

Considering provisions of the ITU Recommendation D90 the Ministry of Transport of the Republic of Latvia kindly asks to confirm the AAIC for the AS RSTA.
