ORGANISATIONAL ISSUES

We are very pleased that you will honour us with your presence at the conference to mark the 75th anniversary of the opening for signature of the European Convention on Human Rights which will be held from 1 to 2 October 2025 in Warsaw.

Please find below necessary information to help you organise your trip to Warsaw.

1. Hotel

We recommend the Sofitel Warsaw Victoria Hotel since we have an agreement with them regarding pricing. We are currently waiting for the hotel to prepare a special reservation link. We will send it to you via email as soon as we receive it.

Please note that the 19th International Fryderyk Chopin Piano Competition in Warsaw will start on 2 October 2025. This may cause some difficulties with the best hotel accommodation in the city centre. We strongly recommend that you make your reservations well in advance.

2. Programme

The final version of the programme of the conference will be send to you as soon as we receive answers to the questionnaire and allocate speakers to the panels. These panels are as follows:

1) The Convention as a tool for judicial review by an administrative court judge; 2) The enforcement of a ECtHR judgement by a national judge and 3) The scope and limits of the margin of appreciation exercised by administrative court judges.
