Sir,

Further to my Circular letter BDT/DNS/DGS/035 dated 1 July 2024, I am writing to extend to you a personal invitation to participate in the 2024 Global Innovation Forum (GIF-24) to be held in Valletta, Malta from 28 to 30 October 2024, under the theme "Shaping our digital futures for prosperity and well-being for all."
