### Invitation

As a follow-up to the fruitful meetings on creative industries and film in Windhoek in March 2025 and May 2026, the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Estonia would like to invite **a total of five-member delegation** from the Namibia Film Commission, the Ministry of Education, Innovation, Youth, Sports, Arts and Culture (MEIYSAC), and the Namibia Investment Promotion and Development Board (NIPDB) to a **study visit to Estonia from 16 to 20 November 2026**.

The purpose of the potential study visit is to strengthen **Creative Industries (CI)** development policy contexts in Namibia and support the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals. The focus of the potential visit is on **film and audio-visual culture**. The visit would include meetings and discussions with several CI stakeholders representing government, civil society, private sector, and academia as well as a participation at PÖFF and PÖFF Industry Programme – one of the 15 A-list film festivals globally that takes place in Tallinn, Estonia 6-22 November 2026.

The visit depends upon a successful **TAIEX funding application** that must be submitted by the Namibia Film Commission to the European Commission prepared in cooperation with the European Union Delegation in Namibia and the Estonian Ministry of Culture. The cost of travel, accommodation, and *per diem* of the study visit's participants would be covered by the European Commission. The details of the TAIEX instrument and study visit agenda will be agreed in detail further on in the process.
