In accordance with the requirements of the International Code for the Security of Ships and of Port Facilities, the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, as amended and the relevant Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council

Under the provisions of clause 95 (8) 1) and of subsection 95 (9) of the Maritime Safety Act, subsection 14 (1) of the Ports Act, regulation 9.2.1 of Chapter XI-2 of the Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, as amended (SOLAS 74/88) and of sections 5.1, 5.6, 5.7, 7.6, 7.8, 9.2, 9.5, 10.1, 13.3, 13.4 and 13.5 of Part A of the International Code for the Security of Ships and of Port Facilities (the ISPS Code) as Annex of Regulation (EC) No 725/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council, the Estonian Transport Administration is issuing the following instructions.
