Dear colleagues,

The Ukrainian Cultural Foundation sincerely presents its compliments to you and has the honor to address with the following.

The whole world is aware of the war that Ukraine is enduring, which is claiming lives, destroying buildings, and ravaging our cultural heritage.

On March 25th, at 10:30, as a result of a missile attack by russian occupational troops on Kyiv, the capital of Ukraine, a section of the Mykhailo Boichuk Kyiv State Academy of Decorative and Applied Arts was destroyed. Fragments of the russian missiles got into the study premises. The atelier of monumental and easel painting, as well as the congress hall, have been destroyed. Furthermore, the Academy's gallery and assembly hall have sustained damage.

In the Congress-Hall of the Academy, there was an ongoing exhibition-competition titled "Woman in the Flames of War," featuring works by students, professors of the Academy, and artists from different parts of Ukraine. Unfortunately, all the works have been destroyed. Additionally, the archives and student theses of the Department of Painting were lost. The Museum of Mykhailo Boichuk's legacy, which housed works from the Boichuk artistic school (1930-1950), has also been destroyed.

Furthermore, all study materials and equipment from the studios, including easels, paints, tablet easels, and plastic ceramic masses used for studying and creating artistic works by both students and professors, were destroyed.
