RISE 2025 represents a new international platform that places women at the center of political and economic dialogue on a sustainable future. The conference brings together ministers, political leaders, representatives of international organizations, the business community, and experts from various sectors and countries that recognize women's empowerment as a prerequisite for the progress of society as a whole. One of the panels during the conference will be organized in cooperation with the United Nations Office in Serbia.

The conference will be held in Belgrade, in a country increasingly recognized as a leader in gender equality policies and the inclusion of women in decision-making processes and the economy. With this initiative, Serbia positions itself as a bridge between developed countries and those still striving for a more equitable position of women in public and private life.
