The Cyprus Presidency of the Council of the European Union is pleased to invite you and your delegation to participate in the Chief Medical , Chief Nursing and Chief Dental Officers Joint Meeting which will take place in Pafos, on 20-21 May 2026.

As an official event of the Cyprus Presidency of the Council of European Union, this Joint Meeting aims to inform, raise awareness and exchange recent best practices and policies for a healthier future generation. Our main goal is to promote and protect the health of children and adolescents in Europe and beyond.

Your participation and contribution to this Joint Meeting would greatly enrich the event and inspire meaningful dialogues throughout its sessions. 
