**Answer to request**

Dear Ms Vinderslev,

We received Your request regarding Directive (EU) 2022/2555 of the European Parliament and of the Council (NIS2 Directive) and its transposition to Estonian law.

We are currently in the process of drafting the national legislation that shall make amendments to our national laws (primarily to our Cybersecurity Act<sup>1</sup>) in order to transpose NIS2 Directive. We conducted our draft law's public consultations and are currently reviewing the feedback so that we can send the revised version of the draft law to the Government of the Republic before this summer and from there to our national parliament (Riigikogu) for passing draft law.

Our general aim is to transpose NIS2 Directive narrowly, hence in the draft law<sup>2</sup> that was in the public consultations, we followed the size criteria as it is foreseen in Article 2 (1) of NIS2 Directive. The same position should remain with the revised text.
