## REQUEST FOR SUPPORT OF UGANDA'S CANDIDATURE FOR ICAO COUNCIL ELECTION

Uganda Civil Aviation Authority (UCAA) presents its compliments to the Civil Aviation Authority of Estonia and has the honour to announce the decision of the Republic of Uganda to seek election to ICAO Council in Part III during the 42nd Session of the Assembly to be held in Montreal, Canada from 23 September to 3 October 2025.

Uganda acceded to the Convention on International Civil Aviation and became a Member State of ICAO in 1967 and has since then actively contributed to the development of safe, secure and sustainable international civil aviation. Under the current Africa's rotation scheme, Uganda will represent the East African States thus ensuring proportional regional representation on the Council. Accordingly, African Civil Aviation Commission (AFCAC) Member States and the Summit of African Union Heads of State have endorsed her candidature.

Considering the existing strong and cordial relationship between our States, Uganda requests the invaluable support of Estonia for her candidacy during Council election. More highlights on Uganda's contribution to civil aviation are contained in the attached Aide Memoire.
