Dear Minister,

We are pleased to invite you to the 2025 Meeting of the OECD Council at Ministerial Level (MCM), which will take place on 3 and 4 June 2025 at the OECD Headquarters in Paris. The 2025 MCM is chaired by Costa Rica, with Australia, Canada, and Lithuania as Vice-Chairs.

In an increasingly challenging environment, trade, investment, and innovation are essential foundations of our shared prosperity. To make globalisation work better for people, we must together tackle the major structural transformations taking place, including the emergence of new digital technologies, and forge innovative and human-centred policies for better lives. The OECD is uniquely positioned to guide these efforts.

The 2025 MCM, themed "*Leading the way towards resilient, inclusive, and sustainable prosperity through rules-based trade, investment and innovation*", will be a unique opportunity to engage in high-level discussions with participation of OECD Members and non-Members on issues critical to today's international economic architecture, including on (i) Resilience - Actively Reinforcing Open Markets and Multilateralism; (ii) Inclusiveness - Leveraging the Digital Economy for Shared Prosperity; and (iii) Sustainability - Building a Sustainable Global Economy Through Innovative Policies.

During the 2025 MCM, we intend to hold discussions on the way forward to expand the OECD's global outreach efforts by enhancing synergies between Regional Programmes, taking stock of their impact, and strengthening regional cooperation and knowledge sharing. This meeting will aim to deepen the regional outreach work of the Organisation, particularly focusing on the Latin American and the Caribbean region.

Invited Partner countries, International Organisations, as well as Business at OECD and the Trade Union Advisory Committee are welcome to all sessions of the MCM, except for sessions designated as Members only or as otherwise specified. Your office is asked to confirm attendance to mcm2025@oecd.org by 14 April 2025.

We look forward to welcoming you to the OECD in June.
