Program Architecture

The Human Capability Initiative (HCI) features sessions delivered across the following stages:



#TheHumanCode Arena

The central plenary and focal point of HCl 2026. It hosts the highest-profile sessions, including the opening, closing, major announcements, and global dialogues. Designed for scale and impact, The Human Code Arena sets the tone of the forum with visionary debates and strategic insights that define how people connect, reason and create.



HCI Dialogues

Held in an enclosed space and, 'in the round,' these group conversations of up to 8 experts have no formal 'front of the room.' The audience will sit around the main table, contributing questions and thoughts. This space is designed to share experiences, insights, and solutions. Participants are expected to contribute equally, with the assistance of a chair.



Announcements and MOUs

This space showcases announcements and signings that turn dialogue into tangible collaboration, demonstrating how institutions activate the Human Code.



Ministerial Roundtable

The Ministerial Roundtable of HCl 2026. It convenes ministers and senior leaders to align on a shared agenda for preparing people for the future and strengthening human capability development. Designed as a collaborative policy space, it forges cross-border partnerships and coordinated action between governments, experts, and international organizations.



Breakout Sessions 1 & 2

Multifunctional learning spaces dedicated to practical skill development and in-depth learning, offering technical insights through interactive workshops, specialized training, hands-on demonstrations, and moderated expert sessions led by Knowledge Partners and industry experts.
