#### The scope of the training

Regulation of the Minister of Transport and Communications No 125 of 21 December 2001 § 65 enacts:

- The applicant shall have completed the theoretical knowledge course and flight instruction approved by the Civil Aviation Administration and in accordance with the qualifications of a free balloon pilot.
  - Applicant shall have passed the examination in the following subjects:
    - 1) Aviation Regulation;
    - 2) Regulations on free balloon flights;
    - 3) Structure of Air Traffic Service and air traffic control procedures;
    - 4) Cross-country navigation, use of aeronautical charts;
    - 5) Construction of free balloons;

6) Operation and maintenance of free balloons, operational limitations, requirements for use of bottled gas;

7) Meteorology;

- 8) Human Factors and Limitations;
- 9) Avoidance of accidents during the flight and operation in emergency conditions.
- Applicant for the free balloon pilot licence shall have completed at least:

1) 12 hours on a free balloon, which shall include at least 10 hours of dual instruction and one hour of solo flight under supervision of a flight instructor;

2) one climb with a flight instructor to at least 1500m;

- 3) 20 take-offs and landings in abnormal wind conditions, including one solo flight;
- 4) at least 6 inflations, deflations and packing of free balloons.

### Credit allowed against Part-BFCL requirements

Credit is given for:

- theoretical knowledge training and examination (except for subjects Principles of flight and Flight performance and planning)
- flight instruction (except total flight time, dual flight time and number of inflations is less than in Balloon regulation)

which meet the requirements of Commission Regulation (EU) 2018/395.

Credit is given for hot-air balloon class group A balloons.

Any requirements the applicant has to comply with in order to be issued with a Part-BFCL licence

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Applicants have to (additionally):

- complete theoretical knowledge instruction and take examination in subjects:
  - Principles of flight
  - Flight performance and planning
- complete flight instruction in such a way that, by the end of the training, the applicant has in hot-air balloons that represent group A of that class at least:
  - 16 hours of flight instruction
  - 12 hours of dual flight instruction
  - o 10 inflations

in accordance with requirements of Commission Regulation (EU) No 2018/395.

List of documents necessary to attest the scope of the training, as well as copies of the national regulations and procedures in accordance with which the training was initiated.
