TRANSPORTS

Arrival at the Hotel Beau-Rivage Palace (for your stay and/or the symposium):

The main entrance to the hotel is located at the rear end of the building (city side). Please note that there is no entrance on the lakeside.

1. Air Travel:

You will be met upon arrival at Geneva or Zurich Airport.

We will provide transport to and from these airports **exclusively** between 14 May and 17 May (end of day).

Your return transfer from your accommodation to the airport will be scheduled **three hours before your flight departure time**.

If you are arriving before 14 May or departing after 17 May, you will need to make your own way to the airport.

Check-in and airport protocol service for your return journey:

Please note that you will need to check in individually at the airport.

If you would like to benefit from the **airport protocol service** for your return flight, **kindly inform us by Monday, 12 May 2025** at the latest so that we can arrange it.

Please be aware that, if you opt for this service, you will not have access to the airport's duty-free shops.

2. Train Travel (for international guests only):

Upon arrival, you will be met at Lausanne railway station, in the main hall opposite the bakery “Le Panetier”, and transferred to your accommodation (or directly to the symposium venue).

For your return journey, your transfer will depart **one hour before your train departure time.**

3. Travel by Private or Official Vehicle:

Please ensure that a parking space is available at your accommodation.

During your stay, for transport between the various event locations, we kindly ask you to use the shuttle service provided between the Hotel Beau-Rivage Palace, the Federal Supreme Court, and the cultural outing venue.

Only authorised persons accompanied by close protection personnel will be permitted to access the Federal Supreme Court by car.

They will be received at the esplanade, and their vehicle may be parked in the Federal Supreme Court car park.

Here are the nearest public car parks to the Court, if needed:

- Mon Repos
- Montbenon
- Coop Caroline

If you are arriving directly on the morning of the symposium and will not be staying overnight in Lausanne, we strongly recommend that you travel by public transport (train followed by metro).

Please note:

The **organised shuttles** will operate exclusively between the Hotel Beau-Rivage Palace (and Hôtel Angleterre) and the Federal Supreme Court (round trip), and the Hotel Beau-Rivage Palace and EPFL.
