The Committee members as well as the Secretariat and interpreters will be in the conference room assigned to the Committee. However, in keeping with the requirements of the Swiss Authorities, the number of people permitted in the Conference Room is limited, the number of delegates present in the room must not exceed to 10 delegates. All delegates who are arriving to attend the in-person meeting must register themselves in [Indico](#) (2 weeks before the session). The State Party delegation is therefore invited to indicate how many members of the delegation (including whether you intend to bring interpreters for national language) intend to participate in the dialogue in-person. The Secretariat will provide the Permanent Mission with relevant details prior to the session.

Due to time constraints for the preparation of the session, please confirm your participation by 28 February 2022.
