## 3. Way forward

The Participants are to strive for mutual cooperation in all aspects of safety investigations and maintain close and regular contact with each other.

This Lot is not a legally binding commitment between the Participants under international or national law.

This Lot may be revisited to ensure continued relevance with regard to its scope.
