It is my honour to invite you to participate in the LTG Forum on Military Mobility and Resilience, which will take place on 17 February 2026 at the Radisson Blu Lietuva Hotel in Vilnius.

Russia's war of aggression against Ukraine has underscored the critical importance of resilient, dualuse infrastructure for Europe's deterrence and defence. Strengthening rapid military mobility across the Eastern flank – through interconnected rail, road, port, airport, energy, and telecommunications networks – remains a shared priority for both NATO and the EU.

In cooperation with the leading organizer of the Forum, LTG Group, we are convening this high-level event to advance military mobility as a strategic European objective.
