The Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) presents his compliments and has the honor to invite Members and Observers to be represented at the first session of the *WIPO ICT Leadership Dialogue* (WILD) which will be held in Geneva, at the headquarters of WIPO, from April 14 to 16, 2025. The WILD sessions will be held daily from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and from 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. (CEST).

The WILD provides a forum for leaders at Intellectual Property (IP) offices or organizations to discuss matters related Information and Communications Technology (ICT) and IP including digital strategies and policy, digital solutions, IP data, implication of emerging technologies for IP administration and related services. It is therefore expected that ICT leaders such as chief information officers or senior management officials such as heads of IP offices will be attending the WILD.
