## RTK information on the first-call results and planned second call

The passages below reproduce the parts of the RTK publication relied upon in the submission. English translations are unofficial working translations.

### First-call results

Original Estonian

Justiits- ja Digiministeeriumi (JDM) ning Riigi Tugiteenuste Keskuse (RTK) toel ja korraldusel käivituvad peagi tööd ülikiiret interneti võimaldava valguskaablivõrgu rajamiseks 6490 majapidamise ja ettevõtte Eesti hajaasustusega piirkondades.

Lairiba juurdepääsuvõrkude viienda toetusmeetme esimeses voorus rahastatakse 37 projekti kogusummas ligi 18,5 miljonit eurot. Kokku esitasid ettevõtted 86 taotlust. ... ühendusi looma asuvad ettevõtted prognoosinud elanike või ettevõtete liitumist pisut enam kui 4000 aadressil.

Unofficial working English translation

With the support and organisation of the Ministry of Justice and Digital Affairs and RTK, work will commence to deploy fibre networks providing ultrafast internet to 6,490 households and businesses in sparsely populated areas of Estonia.

In the first call of the fifth broadband access-network support measure, 37 projects are financed with a total of nearly EUR 18.5 million. Undertakings submitted 86 applications in total. The undertakings deploying connections in the supported areas forecast actual subscriptions by residents or businesses at slightly more than 4,000 addresses.

### Total measure and planned second call

Original Estonian

Lairiba viienda toetusmeetme kogusumma on 45 miljonit eurot, selle meetmega on kavas luua liitumise võimalus kokku vähemalt 10 000 aadressile. Projekte kaasrahastatakse Euroopa Regionaalarengu Fondist.

Järgmised voorud ülikiire internetivõrgu rajamiseks ülejäänud omavalitsustes avanevad edaspidi, 2. voor on planeeritud septembrisse.

Unofficial working English translation

The total amount of the fifth broadband support measure is EUR 45 million and the measure is intended to create a connection possibility for at least 10,000 addresses in total. Projects are co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund.

Further calls for ultrafast internet deployment in the remaining municipalities will follow; the second call is planned for September.

### Arithmetic used in the submission

EUR 18.5 million / 6,490 addresses = approximately EUR 2,850 of public support per address reached. This is an arithmetic derivation from RTK's published aggregate figures, not a separate figure stated by RTK.
