Overview

Taiwan has developed the world's most comprehensive and highly specialized semiconductor industry cluster through long-term national policy support, institutional design, science park development, and a strong talent cultivation system. As the world's leading semiconductor foundry hub and a key node in the global technology supply chain, Taiwan offers valuable experience in policy development, industrial ecosystem building, and industry-academia-research collaboration.

✓ In response to global supply chain restructuring and growing demand for technological autonomy, this program invites European government officials to Taiwan to exchange policy perspectives and explore potential niches and cooperation opportunities within the global semiconductor supply chain, while strengthening technological security, industrial resilience, and Taiwan-Europe strategic partnerships.

Content

- **Policy Dialogue:** Engage in discussions with Taiwanese government bodies (such as the Legislative Yuan, Ministry of Economic Affairs, and Ministry of Education) to exchange views on semiconductor development policies, supply chain resilience strategies, and talent cultivation.
- **Semiconductor Manufacturing and Supply Chain Visits:** Conduct on-site visits to the Hsinchu Science Park and semiconductor industry clusters to observe chip manufacturing, R&D innovation, and supply chain integration.
- **Talent and Innovation:** Visit institutions such as the Taiwan Semiconductor Research Center, TSMC Training Center, Wistron Zhubei AI Smart Park, and technical and vocational education talent training bases to exchange experiences on technical workforce development and R&D innovation, strengthening technological autonomy and industrial competitiveness.
- **Cooperation Exploration:** Exchange perspectives on the global semiconductor supply chain and explore opportunities for future technological collaboration and industrial linkages.
