ACCOMMODATION

LANGUAGE OF THE CONFERENCE

All Conference events will be conducted in Azerbaijani, English, and Arabic with simultaneous translation available.

ON THE GROUND TRANSPORTATION

The event organizers will handle the arrangements for airport pick-up and drop-off services.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The metro system in Baku city is the sole metro system in the country, operating from 6 am to midnight. The stations, trains, and facilities are well-maintained, ensuring cleanliness and safety. Trains run at a frequency of approximately every two to three minutes.

Currently, the Baku Metro consists of three metro lines: the Red Line (Qırmızı xətt), the Green Line (Yaşıl xətt), and the Purple Line (Bənövşəyi xətt), encompassing a total of 27 metro stations. For additional information, please visit <http://www.metro.gov.az/en>.

Buses offer an affordable means of transportation within Baku. Bus cards can be obtained and topped up at metro and bus stops for convenient use.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Republic of Azerbaijan is a country located at the boundary of Eastern Europe and Western Asia. It is a part of the South Caucasus region and is bounded by the Caspian Sea to the east, Russia to the north, Georgia to the northwest, Armenia and Turkey to the west, and Iran to the south.

CAPITAL CITY

Baku is the capital and the largest city.

CLIMATE

In Azerbaijan, the climate is slightly continental, with relatively cold winters and hot summers; it is also arid in most of the low-lying areas, while it is colder and generally rainier in the mountains. The coast on the Caspian Sea is semi-arid in the northern part and arid in the center (see Baku), while it is rainy in the southernmost stretch, which is, therefore, an exception to the rule that the plains of Azerbaijan are arid.

POPULATION

10.2 million.

LANGUAGE

Azerbaijani (official).

CURRENCY

The currency in Azerbaijan is the Azerbaijani Manat (AZN). USD and EURO are easily exchanged in the banks. Exchange rate of USD is approximately 1,70 AZN.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INTERNET

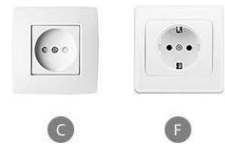
The international phone country code for Azerbaijan is +994. Wi-Fi connections are commonly available in cafes, parks, and restaurants throughout the country.

For Azerbaijan, there are two associated plug types, types C and F. Plug type C is the plug that has two round pins and plug type F is the plug that has two round pins with two earth clips on the side. Azerbaijan operates on a 220V supply voltage and 50Hz.
