## **Confirmation letter**

Dear Ms. Frediani

On behalf of the Ministry of Justice and Digital Affairs of the Republic of Estonia, we confirm that according to Article 2, Section 1 of the <u>Sworn Translators Act</u> in Estonia, only individuals who have been granted the profession of a sworn translator based on and in accordance with the procedure established by the Sworn Translators Act may engage in the professional activities of a sworn translator under this title. The profession of a sworn translator is certified by a professional certificate issued by the minister responsible for the area.

The Ministry of Justice and Digital Affairs of the Republic of Estonia maintains a list of sworn translators, including information on their professional certificates, and makes this information publicly available on its official website. <u>Here</u> are contact details of all Estonian sworn translators, including professional certificate of a sworn translator issued by the minister.

The Ministry of Justice and Digital Affairs of the Republic of Estonia confirms that, on 31st of January 2014, the minister issued professional certificate No. 22 to Andrea Bochese, certifying his competence to translate documents from Estonian to Spanish, form Estonian to Italian and from Italian to Estonian.
