- **Detailed Proposal Submission:** Clearly outline the specifics of your exhibition. This includes the topic of your exhibition, the equipment you need and any unique requirements that your exhibit may have.
- **Stand Size Selection:** Choose from the available options of a standard or large booth. If opting for a larger booth, please provide a justification for the additional space needed.
- **Financial Responsibilities:** Note that while stand space and storage facilities are provided by the organisers, the costs associated with travel, accommodation, and shipping of materials are to be covered by the exhibitors themselves.
- **Interactive and Engaging Exhibits:** We highly value and encourage interactive formats and displays that actively engage visitors and contribute to the dynamic environment of the Exhibition Village.

Given the limited space in the Exhibition Village, we will carefully review all applications to select those that best complement the Forum's objectives and themes. Preference will be given to exhibits that demonstrate innovation, collaboration, and engagement potential.

We will do our best to provide all applicants with selection decision by 15 March. We look forward to your innovative contributions to make the 2024 European Civil Protection Forum a landmark event.
