### **Tenth edition of the WHO report on the global tobacco epidemic**

The World Health Organization is committed to providing Member States with accurate, relevant, internationally comparable information to guide the development of health policy and to evaluate the impact of those policies. An example of this type of information source is the *WHO report on the global tobacco epidemic*, which WHO has published regularly since 2008. WHO is currently collecting data for the tenth edition of the report, planned for publication in mid-2025, and we would like to extend an invitation to your Ministry to participate.

The WHO European Region will conduct the survey for this report at regional level, in accordance with the current WHO global policy on use of surveys for data collection.
