Dear World Bank Group Governors of the Nordic and Baltic constituency,


In line with the agreed rotation schedule for positions at the Nordic-Baltic office in the World Bank, Sweden will, as of July 2024, fill the position of the Executive Director until the 30th of June 2028. In the same period, Sweden will serve as the coordinating country for the Nordic-Baltic Constituency.
