WITH REFERENCE to Focused Circular No 27(24), dated 26 March 2024, by which the Member States of the HCCH were invited to cast their votes before 26 September 2024, in accordance with Article 2 of the HCCH's Statute, on the proposal made by the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands for the admission of the **Kingdom of Bahrain** as a Member of the HCCH;

WHEREAS no Member State has cast a vote against the admission within the period of time provided;


