sTESTA: a pre-condition for CECIS

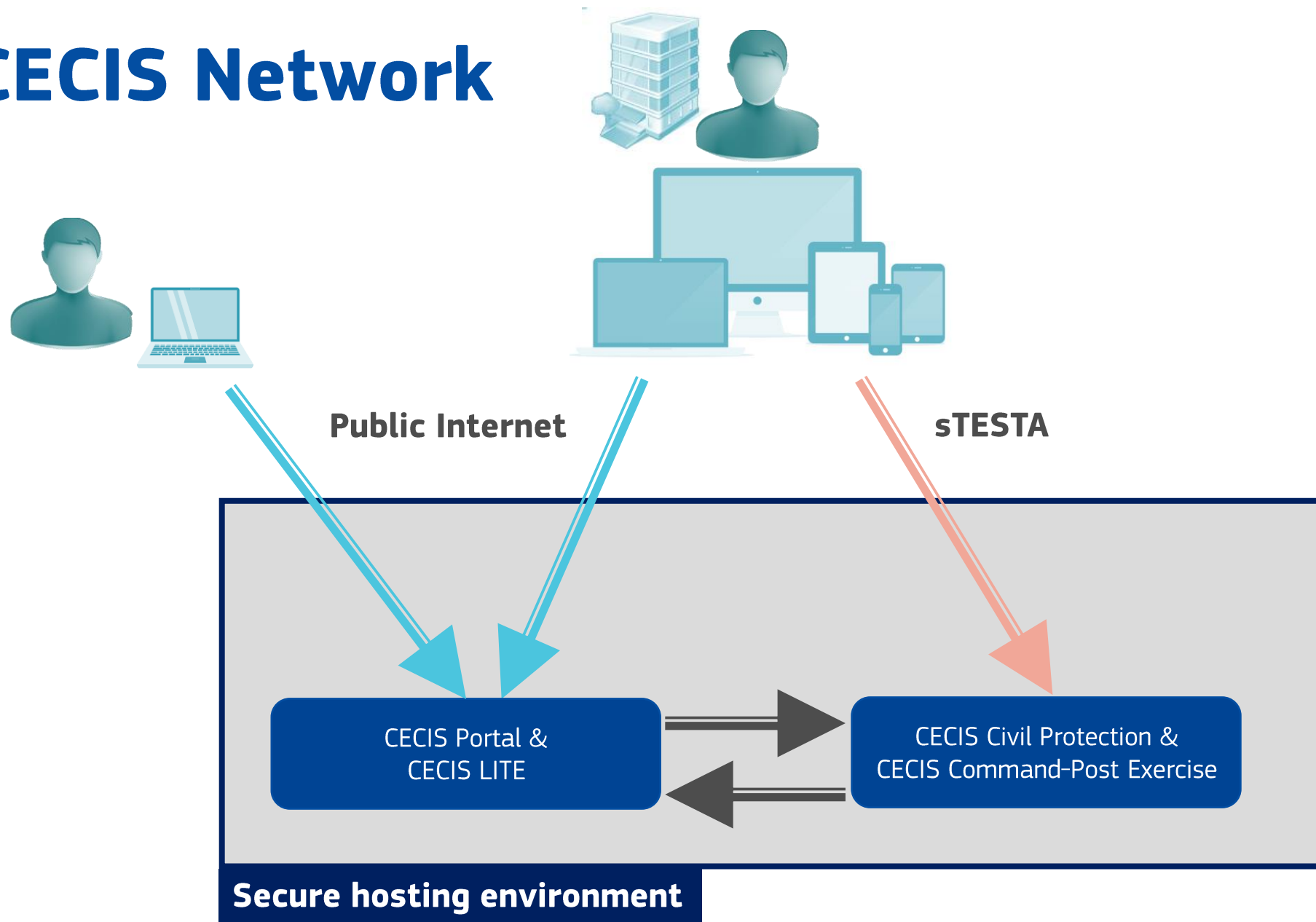
What is sTESTA?

- A pre-condition for CECIS is the existence of **sTESTA connection** in the country.
- sTESTA is a secured IP-based network owned by the EU. It is an interconnection platform that ensures secure information exchange between European public administrations.

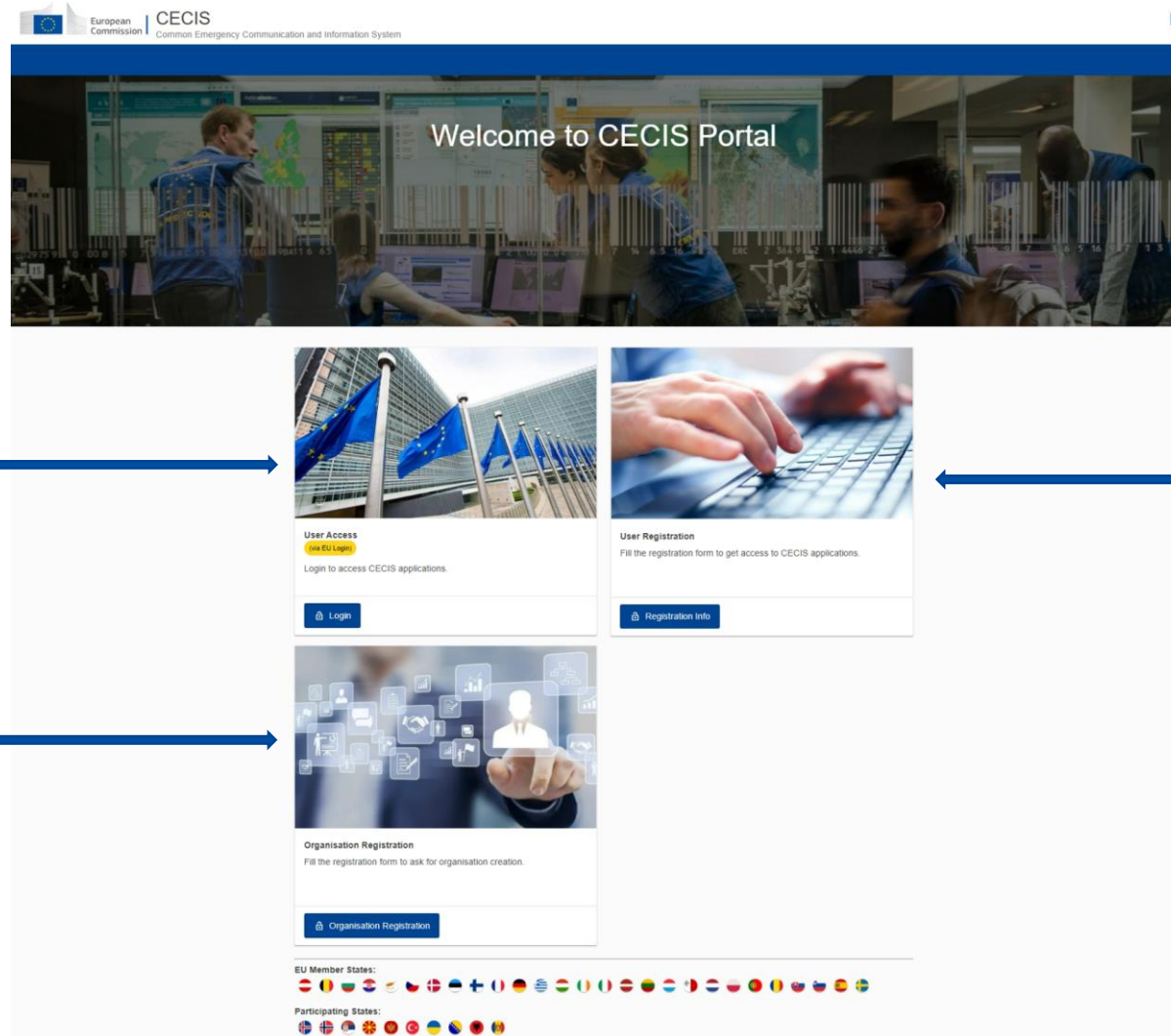
Who currently has access to CECIS?

- **All 27 EU MS + 2 PS** (IS & NO) **have sTESTA** and full access to CECIS.
- **8 PS** (AL, BA, MD, ME, MK, RS, TR, UA) **do not have sTESTA**.

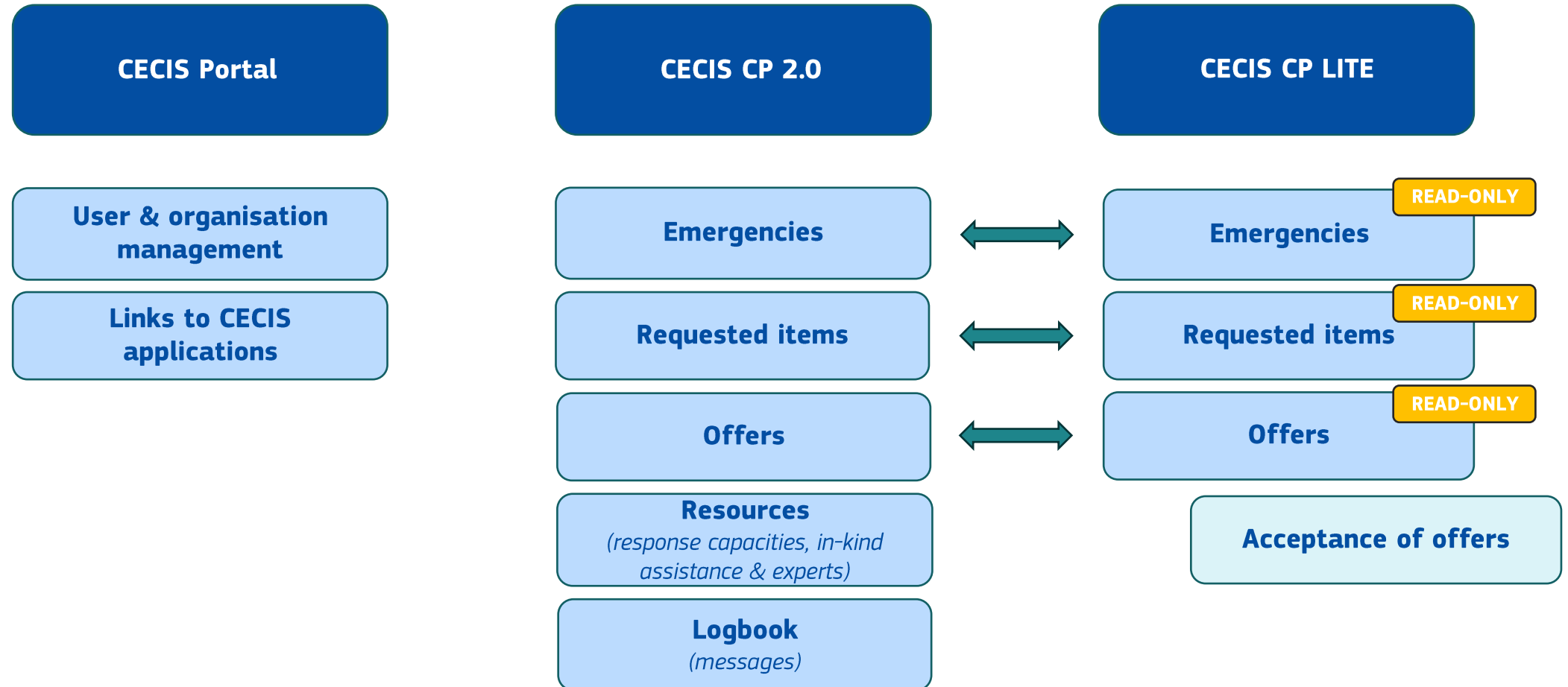

CECIS LITE for who?

- Participating States who do not have sTESTA (*AL, BA, MD, ME, MK, RS, TR, UA*)
- Other organisations in MS/PS to whom CP authorities would like to give CECIS CP access to (*i.e. MoH, MoFA*)
- Experts deployed in UCPM missions
- Third countries or international organisations to accept UCPM offers

User Management

- All MS/PS to ensure all colleagues within their organisation who will need access to CECIS have created their **individual EU login accounts** and have been granted access to CECIS 2.0.
- Each user will need to have their own personal EU login account, we will not allow the use of generic accounts for security reasons. Avoid the use of non-corporate e-mail accounts.

Cross-sectoral approach to user management

General Administrator: ERCC

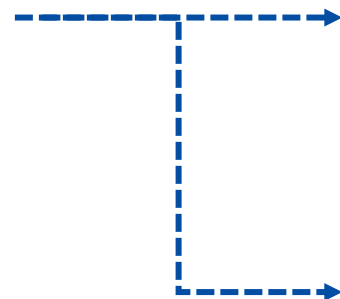
Manages role of national administrators at each MS/PS CP authority



National administrator:

Grants access to CECIS CP and assigns privileges (read-only, read/write) to other organisations

Example: **BE Directorate-General for Civil Protection**



BE MoFA

☒ Read/write access:

All COVID-19 repatriation emergencies



BE MoFA **local administrator*** can grant either **read-only** or **read/write** access to its users

BE MoH

☒ Read-only access:

Ukraine emergency only



BE MoH **local administrator** can only grant **read-only** access to its users

***Local administrator:** *Grants access to CECIS CP and assigns privileges (read-only, read/write) to users within its organisation*

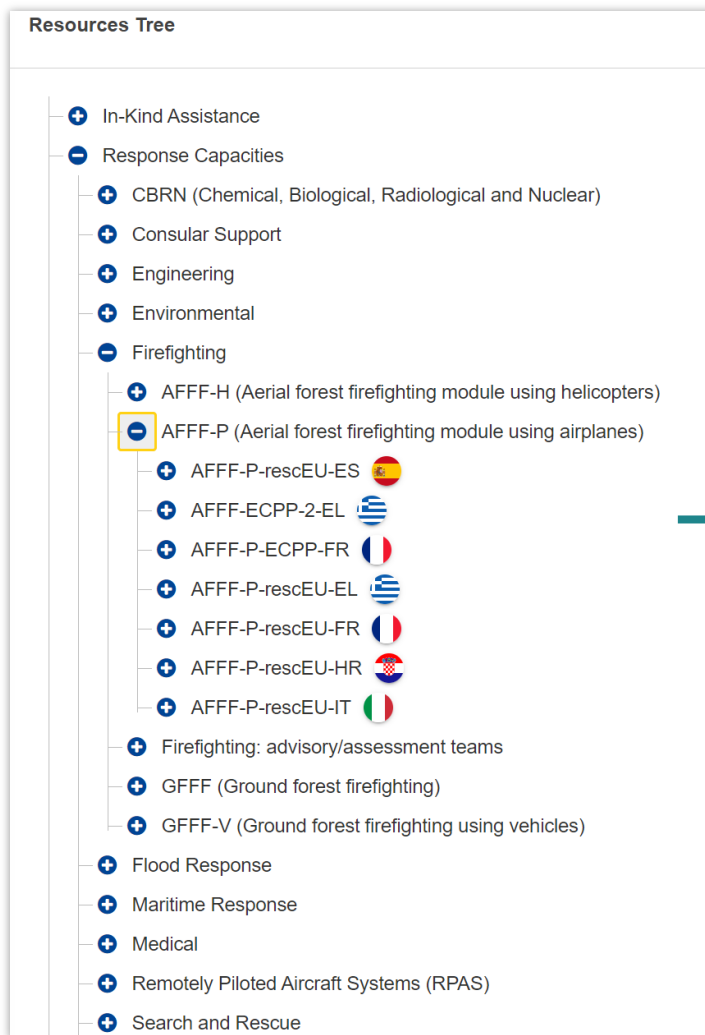

Resource and Unit Management

Key changes & new functionalities:

- Your assistance (whether response capacities/modules, in-kind assistance or experts) **must be registered before it can be offered**. This registration is **mandatory** in CECIS 2.0 for all assistance.
- **Simplified resource tree** with **search box** functionality
- **Search engine for units** with multiple filters
- Integration of **factsheet templates**
- **Registration of multiple in-kind assistance** through the application or via CSV template

UCPM Activation

Key changes & new functionalities:

- **Interactive maps** in emergency overview
- **Filtering options** in **emergency overview**
- Extended list of **causes and types of events**
- **Emergency map** highlighting affected area(s) (e.g. region(s), sub-region(s), ad hoc drawn polygons)
- **Filtering options** in **request overview**
- **Adding multiple requests** and **requested items**
- **Adding multiple offers** (i.e. matching available stockpile with requests)

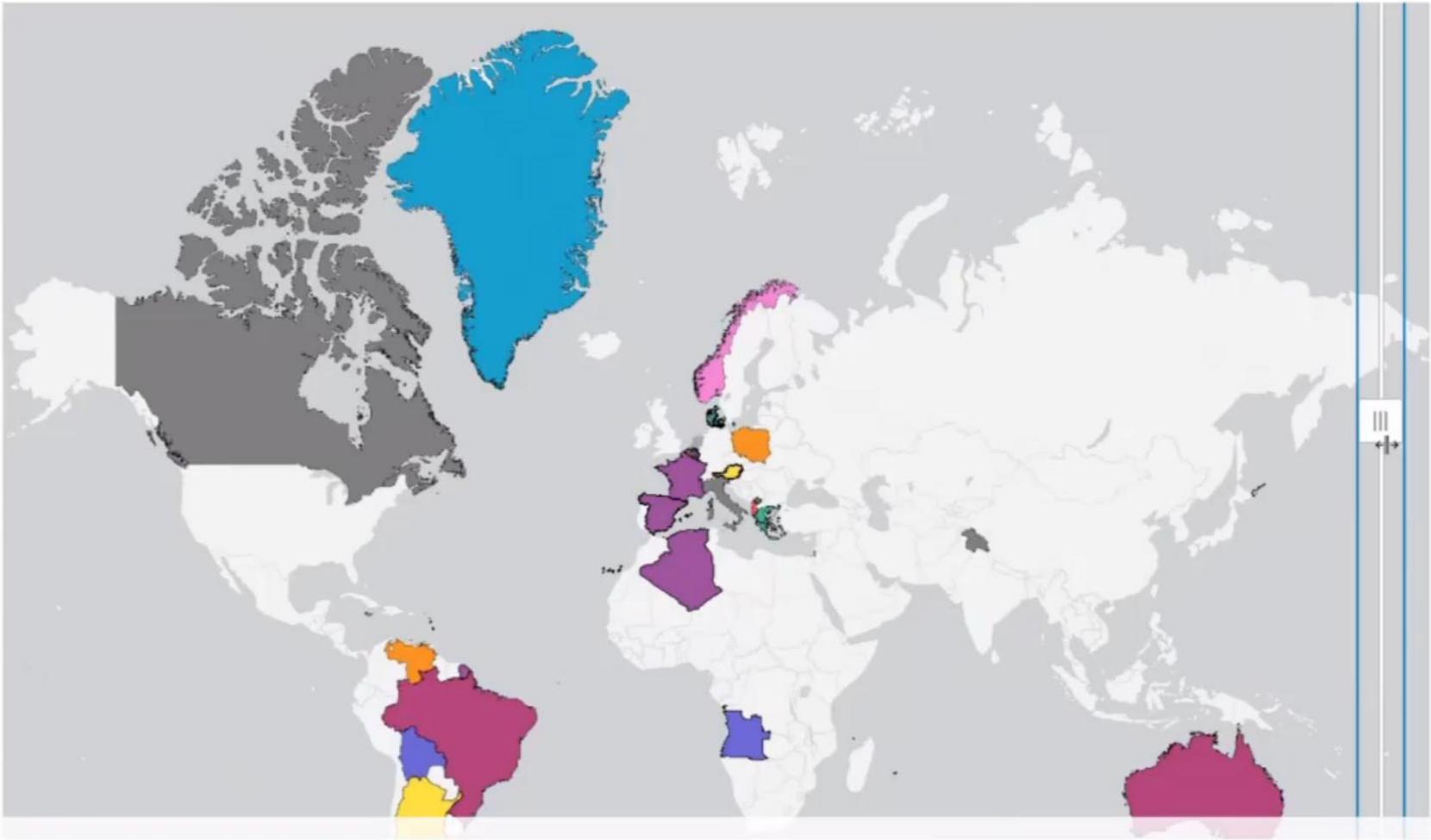
