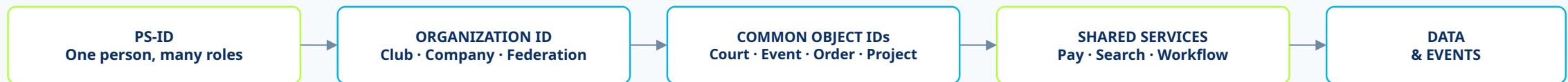
The system is designed so that new countries and services are activated mainly through configuration and localization, not by rebuilding the platform.

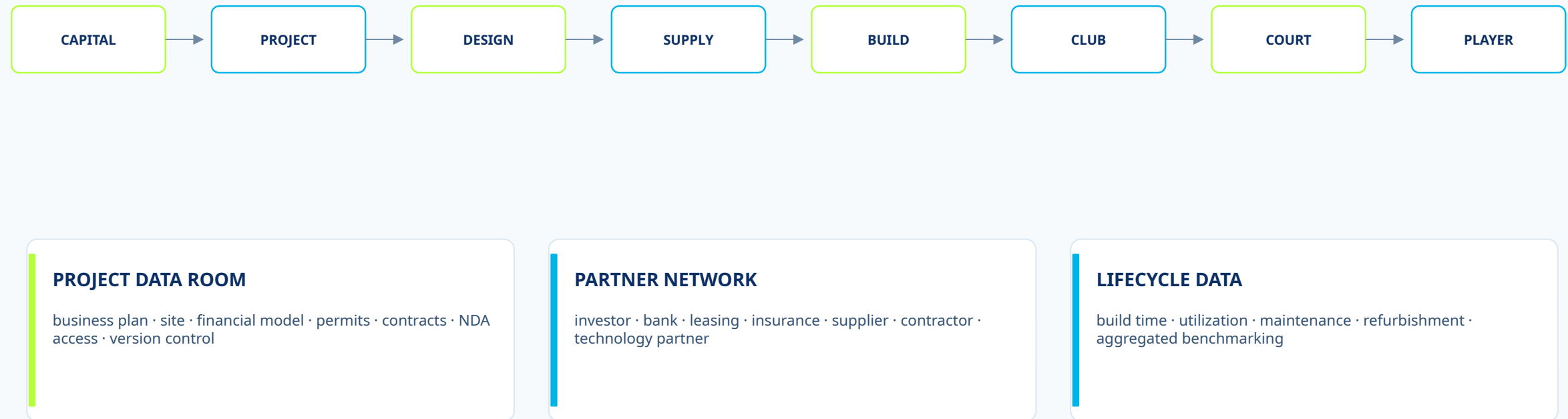

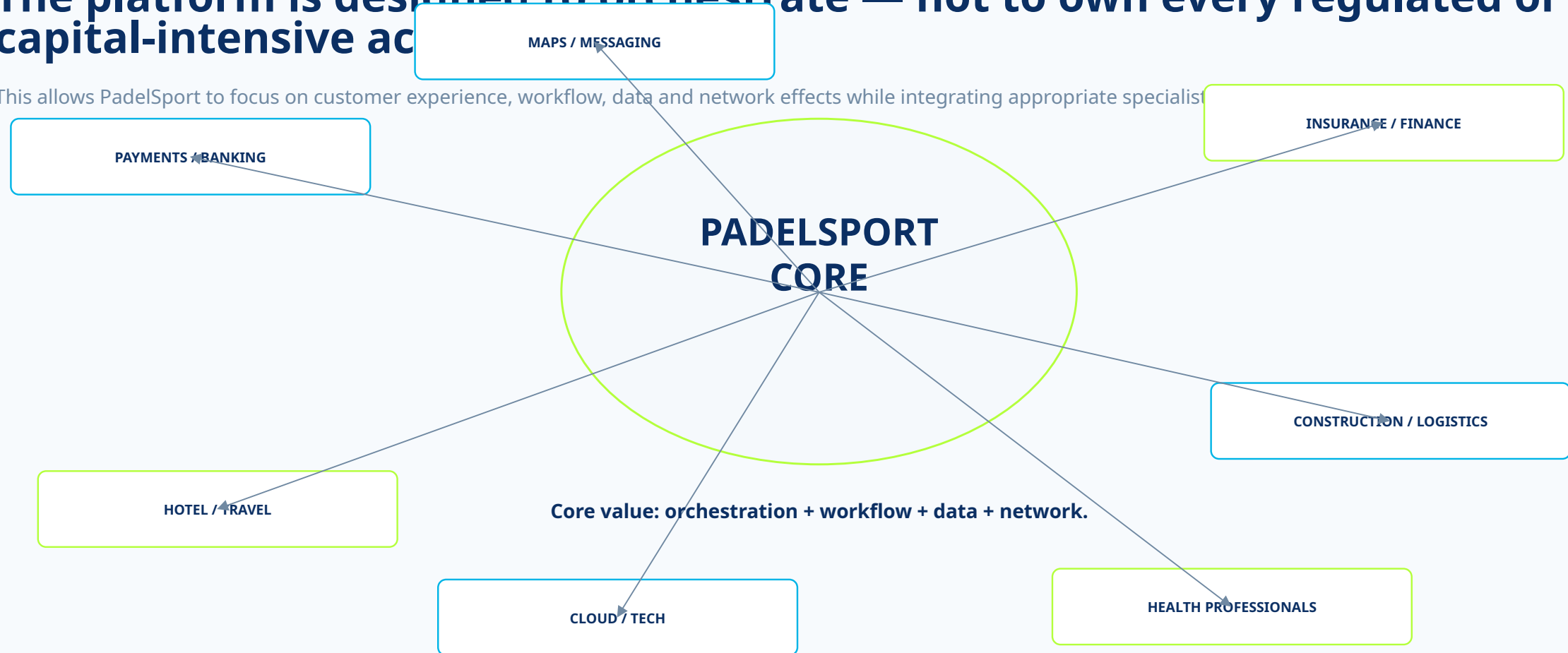
From capital to a functioning court — through one project lifecycle.

This allows PadelSport to focus on customer experience, workflow, data and network effects while integrating appropriate specialists



Why a shared network can be more efficient than many separate systems.

The economic logic comes from reuse of common components, not from the number of domains itself.

SHARED IDENTITY	one auth / role / consent system	less duplication
SHARED PAY	Booking, Events, Marketplace and Travel	more consistent checkout
SHARED DATA MODEL	one Club / Court / User / Project record	fewer contradictions
CONFIG-FIRST	activate countries and domains by configuration	faster rollout potential
SHARED ADMIN	domain, club, partner and country control tower	lower operating complexity
PARTNERED INFRASTRUCTURE	cloud / PSP / specialist integrations	less capital-intensive ownership

Any cost advantage must be validated in real operation; the architecture creates the potential, not a guarantee.

Scale requires clear ownership, rights, data controls and institutional boundaries.

The system is designed so that trust is embedded in the architecture rather than added later as a compliance layer.

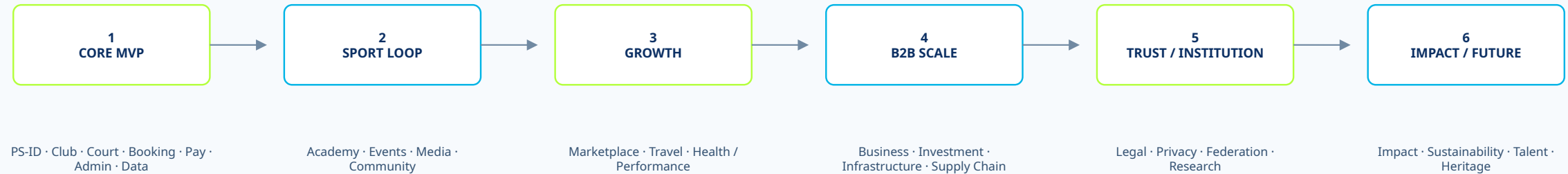
