We are pleased to invite you to the **Justice Leaders' Dialogue** on “Shaping the future of justice: building a system that earns trust and delivers shared prosperity” on 12 November 2025 in Madrid, Spain.

The Justice Leaders' Dialogue is taking place as part of the 10th OECD Global Roundtable on Equal Access to Justice, on 12-14 November, co-hosted by the Ministry of the Presidency, Justice and Parliamentary Relations of Spain and in collaboration with the Open Government Partnership and the Pathfinders for a Peaceful, Just and Inclusive Society.

The Dialogue will convene Ministers of Justice, Attorneys General, and senior officials to shape the justice systems of the future as pillars of trust, resilience, and shared prosperity. As countries navigate today's challenges and public expectations, the need for agile, responsive, and future-oriented justice institutions has come to the fore. The Dialogue will explore how effective and people-centred justice systems can serve as engines of economic competitiveness and social stability by ensuring legal certainty, facilitating dispute resolution, and fostering equal opportunities.

Key discussions will focus on:

- Delivering justice as a public service by centring justice around user needs and leveraging innovation to improve outcomes, streamline services, and enhance efficiency;
- Harnessing data-driven justice solutions to gain deeper insights into justice experiences, proactively address legal needs, and boost economic performance; and
- Rebuilding trust and engagement by making justice more accessible, through local and people-centred approaches that empower individuals and strengthen democratic ties.
