**Subject: Joint Invitation to the World Law Congress 2027**

Dear President ,

On behalf of the World Jurist Association and the Supreme Court of Albania, it is our shared honor to jointly invite you to participate in the upcoming **30<sup>th</sup> World Law Congress, to be held in Tirana, Albania, from 3 to 5 May 2027.**

Since its first edition in 1963, the World Law Congress has served as a global meeting point for jurists, heads of state and government, judges of national and international courts, academics, and civil society. It stands today as one of the most enduring and influential gatherings of the international legal community, bringing together leaders from across continents around a shared commitment: the advancement of the rule of law as the foundation of peace, stability, and human dignity.

The World Jurist Association, with more than six decades of history and consultative status with the United Nations, has consistently upheld a simple but powerful principle that continues to guide its mission: a world governed by law, not force. Through its Congresses and global initiatives, the Association seeks to promote dialogue, strengthen legal institutions, and reaffirm the central role of law in democratic life.

As the highest court of ordinary jurisdiction, entrusted with ensuring the uniform interpretation and application of the law throughout the Republic, it considers the World Law Congress a defining moment for Albania and for the broader community of supreme jurisdictions. It is in this spirit that the Supreme Court of Albania joins the World Jurist Association in personally extending this invitation to its peers, expressing the sincere wish to welcome you in Tirana and to count on your presence alongside its sister courts from across the world.

It would be a true privilege to count on your presence and contribution to this global dialogue. Your experience and leadership would undoubtedly enrich the discussions and reinforce our shared commitment to defending and advancing the rule of law at a time when its foundations are increasingly under strain.
