Annual Letter of Information

to all Presidents, Rectors, (Rector-) Commandants & Superintendents of European Union Basic Officer Education Institutions (EU-BOEIs)

Dear President, dear Rector, dear (Rector-) Commandant, dear Superintendent, dear Dean!

As the Chairman of the European Union Military Erasmus (EMILYO) Implementation Group (IG) — a configuration of the European Security and Defence College's (ESDC) Executive Academic Board (EAB) — please allow me to pass this annual letter on behalf of all the IG members to you.

First of all, I would like to wish a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year to you, to your family, and to your institution.

Based on the 2008-decision of all European Union Ministers of Defence (2903rd External Relations Council Meeting) an Implementation Group was to be established for the so-called "European Initiative for the exchange of young officers inspired by Erasmus", or with other names "Military Erasmus", "Erasmus Militaire", "EMILYO" (Exchange of MILitary Young Officers) or just in short "The Initiative".

The overall goal & mandate is to harmonise the European Union Basic Officer Education, to increase interoperability, and to promote a European Security and Defence Culture, thus, to increase Europe's security.

In fulfilling the above-mentioned mandate, during the year 2024 the Implementation Group continued with the quarterly meetings. Moreover, the IG-linked international Military Academic Forum 2024 (iMAF 2024) and the European Union Military Academies Commandants' Seminar 2024 (EUMACS 2024) & European Air Force Academies Commandants' Conference (EUAFA-CC) were **outstandingly** organised by the Henri Coandă Air Force Academy in Brasov and the Royal Military Academy in Brussels.

Please find below the statistics concerning Cadets/Midshipmen/Students exchanges of the past study years based on data your institution sent. You can see that the study year 2023/2024 has been the most successful one ever since!

Each year the ESDC creates the so-called "Annual Report". The report 2023-2024 should reach you via the Ministries of Foreign Affairs, the Ministries of Defence, and/or your (military) chain of command within the next months. This report comprises — among other recommendations — also the future goals for the Implementation Group based on the feed-backs of all EU-BOEIs and which are:

- Ensure that all Basic Officer Education Institutions are involved in EMILYO.
- Review and update the existing Common Modules according to the SQF-MILOF guidelines.
- Implementation of the European Common Technical Semester on Defence and Security (E_UCTS_{DS}) and launch of new projects for international semesters in the fields of Air Defence, Logistics, and Navy.
- Establishment of the new Line of Developments on Space and on Hybrid Warfare.
- Encourage all EU institutions in organising EMILYO activities and/or sending Cadets/ Midshipmen/ Students.
- Ensure all EU-MS to opt-in the EMILYO Framework Agreement.

<u>Plans for 2025</u>: We will continue with our quarterly IG meetings. The Romanian Naval Academy "Mircea cel Batran" will organise the annual **iMAF 2025** from 02-06 June 2025. The Military Technical University in Warsaw and the Polish Air Force University in Deblin will organise the annual **EUMACS 2025** for <u>all</u> services back-to-back with the **EUAFA-Commandants' Conference** from 27-30 May 2025. We would very much appreciate if you could participate in these promising events.
