The Global Innovation Index 2024 Unlocking the Promise of Social Entrepreneurship

Global launch: Thursday, September 26, 2024 (13:30–15:30 CEST) WIPO Headquarters, Geneva, Switzerland

The Global Innovation Index 2024 (GII) takes the pulse of innovation against a background of steady but slow global economic growth, shrinking innovation finance, and sluggish productivity growth.

Tracking the most recent global innovation trends, the GII finds that innovation investments have slowed in 2023, a strong reversal from prior years, making the outlook for 2024 and 2025 more uncertain than ever.

This year's GII ranks the innovation performance of 133 economies, showcasing their innovation strengths and weaknesses.

Under the title "Unlocking the Promise of Social Entrepreneurship", this year's GII shows how a flurry of new social entrepreneurship ventures is finding innovative solutions addressing critical societal issues. It helps innovation policymakers and innovation support schemes to better scale social ventures for improved systemic impact.



Since 2007, the GII has been both an invaluable reference tool for countries to benchmark innovation performance and improve innovation policy and its impact. The UN General Assembly recognizes the *GII* as an authoritative benchmarking tool for measuring innovation in the context of the Sustainable Development Goals.

The GII is published by WIPO in partnership with the Portulans Institute.
