Dear Mr. Diderich

I am writing to inform you that Estonia will contribute an amount of 2000 (two thousand) EUR to support the work on Environment, Health and Safety Programme, Output Result 2.3.3 Environment, Health and Safety (including Chemicals), which the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) will carry out, as part of its Programme of Work and Budget for 2025-2026.

The continuation of any outputs beyond 2026 is subject to the inclusion of such outputs in the OECD's future Programme(s) of Work and Budget.

This amount will be paid in full on upon receipt of an invoice from the OECD.

The OECD will issue the invoice(s) in accordance with its standard invoicing procedures and submit the invoice(s) to in the form of PDF file(s) sent via email. The OECD shall not be required to use any electronic system for submitting invoice(s) under this Agreement, including, but not limited to, by providing direct input through a platform operated by or on behalf of Estonia.



All outputs of the project, in whatever form, will be the sole property of the OECD.

Any disagreement arising out of or relating to the interpretation of, compliance with or execution of this contribution shall be resolved by the Parties by mutual agreement.

The present letter and your confirmation of acceptance shall form a binding agreement between us.
