INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE USMA 2025 FOREIGN ACADEMY EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Dear Brigadier General Kalnitski,

The Office of Defense Cooperation presents its compliments to the Estonian Military Academy and has the honor of inviting two Military Academy Cadets to the United States Military Academy (USMA) at West Point as participants in the Foreign Academy Exchange Program (FAEP).

The FAEP consists of two distinct phases. The first phase sends two USMA Cadets to Estonia 14-23 March 2025 including travel time. The United States will fund the travel expenses for the two Cadets with Estonia covering the hosted in-country costs for lodging, meals, and travel. The second phase sends two Estonian Military Cadets to West Point in the United States from 03-13 April 2025 including travel time. Estonia will pay for the airfare and incidentals for the two Estonian Cadets, while the United States will cover lodging, meals, and transportation.
